**pfbtops** – translate Printer Font Binary files to PostScript ASCII

**SYNOPSIS**

**pfbtops** [*pfb-file*]

**pfbtops --help**

**pfbtops -v**

**pfbtops --version**

**DESCRIPTION**

*pfbtops* translates a PostScript font in Printer Font Binary (PFB) format to ASCII, splitting overlong lines in text packets into smaller chunks. If *pfb-file* is omitted, the PFB file will be read from the standard input. The ASCII format PostScript font will be written on the standard output. PostScript fonts for MS-DOS are normally supplied in PFB format.

The resulting ASCII format PostScript font can be used with groff, if it is first listed in */usr/share/groff/1.22.4/font/devps/download* and */usr/share/groff/1.22.4/font/devpdf/download*.
