`pfbtops` – translate Printer Font Binary files to PostScript ASCII

SYNOPSIS

`pfbtops` [*pfb-file*]

`pfbtops --help`

`pfbtops -v`

`pfbtops --version`

DESCRIPTION

pfbtops translates a PostScript font in Printer Font Binary (PFB) format to ASCII, splitting overlong lines in text packets into smaller chunks. If *pfb-file* is omitted, the PFB file will be read from the standard input. The ASCII format PostScript font will be written on the standard output. PostScript fonts for MS-DOS are normally supplied in PFB format.

The resulting ASCII format PostScript font can be used with `groff`, if it is first listed in `/usr/share/groff/1.22.4/font/devps/download` and `/usr/share/groff/1.22.4/font/devpdf/download`.
