DESCRIPTION

gcov-dump is a tool you can use in conjunction with GCC to dump content of gcda and gcno profile files offline.

OPTIONS

-h
--help
Display help about using **gcov-dump** (on the standard output), and exit without doing any further processing.

-l
--long
Dump content of records.

-p
--positions
Dump positions of records.

-v
--version
Display the **gcov-dump** version number (on the standard output), and exit without doing any further processing.

-w
--working-sets
Dump working set computed from summary.
